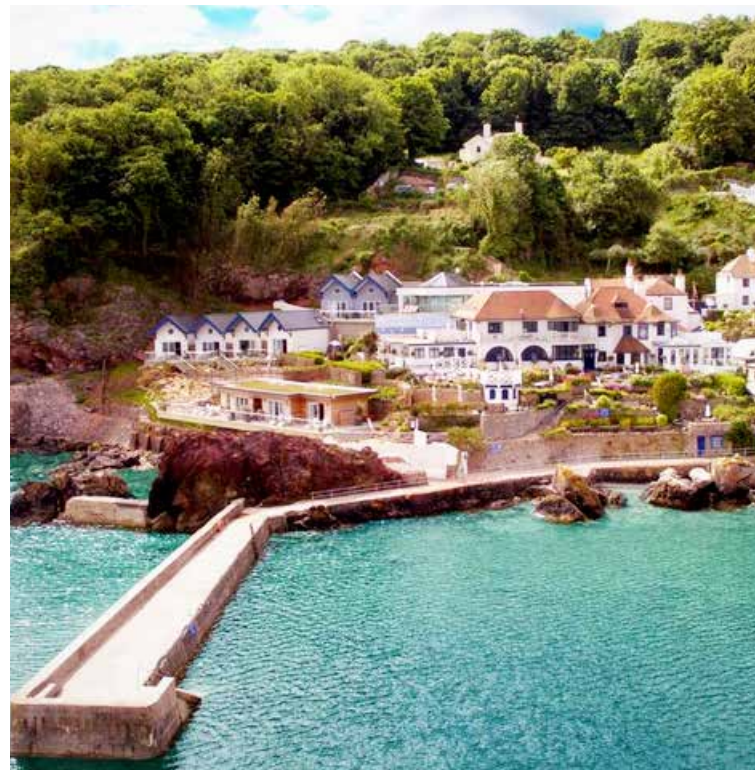

# Della Vite

Della Vite is a range of award-winning and sustainably made Proseccos, created by Chloe, Poppy and Cara Delevingne.

Taking its name from the Italian term for “of the vine”, the first joint venture between the sisters sees them partnered with a third-generation wine making family – the Biasiottos - whose winery is based in the Prosecco region of Valdobbiadene, Northern Italy. Della Vite fuses the latest technology with traditional production methods to produce high-quality, vegan-certified wines that capture the untold story of Prosecco’s heritage, craft and provenance.

Launched in late summer 2020, the wines have been widely acclaimed by Michelin starred restaurants, the world’s best bars and the media.

A floral, pastry rich Champagne, Pol Roger Brut Réserve is blended  
from 30 wines from different vineyards and vintages. The result is

- 7 **TAITTINGER BRUT RÉSERVE** BOTTLE £89.00  
On the palate, this lively fresh wine is at once in harmony.

### PRESTIGE CUVÉE

- 9  **DOM PÉRIGNON BRUT** BOTTLE £250.00  
Dom Pérignon is named after the cellar master at Hautvillers (1670-1715)  
who perfected the sparkling wine-making process that created  
Champagne, the drink that we know today.
- 10  **LOUIS ROEDERER CRISTAL** BOTTLE £350.00  
Cristal was created in 1876 to satisfy the demanding tastes of Tsar Alexander II.  
The emperor asked Louis Roederer to reserve the House's best cuvée for him every year.  
To distinguish this cuvée, this exceptional champagne came in a flat-bottomed, transparent  
lead-crystal bottle. Produced uniquely during the best years, when the Chardonnay and  
Pinot noir grapes have attained perfect maturity, Cristal is aged for 6 years in Louis Roederer's  
cellars. Cristal is a remarkably balanced and refined champagne whose length is inimitable.  
It has a silky texture and fruity aromas, complemented by a powerful mineral quality with  
white fruit and citrus notes.
- 11  **WINSTON CHURCHILL POL ROGER** BOTTLE £295.00  
Pol Roger created this Champagne as a tribute to Sir Winston Churchill, allegedly,  
Churchill valued a robust, full bodied Champagne, and this vintage is one that  
Pol Roger hope he would have approved of. Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill is made  
exclusively with grapes from Grand Cru Pinot Noir and Chardonnay vineyards which  
were already under vine during Churchill's lifetime. On the palate, the wine is  
immediately powerful and yet exquisitely well-balanced; refreshing flavours of  
citrus fruit, notably grapefruit, are coupled with creamy notes of pastry.

LOIRE, FRANCE  
Domaine Michel Girard comprises of 12 hectares of vineyards, made up of 30 parcels of vines with an average age of 15 years. Terroir plays an important role at this estate. Michel, Philippe and Benot Girard's vines are planted on each of Sancerre's three different soil types. The brothers favour judicious blending of the separately-vinified cuvees to create wines with real complexity and balance.
- 30 **V** **LE CLOS PEYRASSOL** BOTTLE £90.00  
PROVENCE, FRANCE  
One of the best Provence roses from the original home of the Knights Templars using Tibouren, a very old Provençal variety, predominates and gives this great wine its personality. Grenache and Rolle complete the blend. Beneath its very delicate colour with hints of purple, Clos Peyrassol reveals a complex nose: notes of white flowers, heather and vine peach combine to form an elegant bouquet. The robust, rounded attack develops into a beautiful depth of palate. It is seductive in its smoothness and vivacity, its all-enveloping roundedness and its remarkably long-lasting aroma.

## REDS FROM THE DE SAVARY CELLAR

- 51 **NUITS ST GEORGE** BOTTLE £120.00  
**DOMAINE JEROME CHEZEAUX**  
COTES DE NUITS, BURGUNDY, FRANCE  
The Chezeaux family owns almost four hectares of vineyards within the village appellation of Nuits Saint Georges. The vineyards are found within a number of lieu-dits but the ultimate cuvée that is bottled is principally from the Charbonniere site supplemented by Les Chaliots and Aux Saint Julien. The vines are very old, some being planted over eighty years ago. The soil is a mix of silts of clay, reddish-brown in colour, overlain with limestone pebbles. Exquisite aromas and flavours of blackcurrant, black cherry, cocoa and clove. Firmly structured and robust on the palate with a stylish and elegant finish.
- 52 **BEAUNE IER CRU 'LES CENT'S VIGNES'** BOTTLE £110.00  
**DOMAINE JESSIAUME**  
COTES DE BEAUNE, BURGUNDY, FRANCE  
The domaine is located in the village of Santenay and was founded in 1850. Five generations of the Jessiaume family have managed the Domaine, which is presently owned by former Rangers F.C. chairman Sir David Murray (whose vinous passion began in the 1980s) and his son Keith Murray. The winemaking is in the hands of siblings Marc and Pascal Jessiaume, as well as Marc's son Jean-Baptiste, who won best young winemaker at last year's Hospice de Beaune auction. Striking deep scarlet colour leads on to aromas of black and red fruits. On the palate, its solid, mouth-filling structure makes it a wine that is generous, straightforward, and with the power to charm.
- 53 **CHATEAU LEOVILLE BARTON 2EME CRU** BOTTLE £240.00  
ST JULIEN, BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Consistently brilliant quality in recent years, Anthony Barton always makes a top quality Bordeaux of classic proportions here. The wine is made from 83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot and 2% Cabernet Franc in 60% new oak. This has a classic cedary Medocain nose with hints of pencil shavings and cigar box. On the palate it is superbly balanced with fine tannins, brooding and powerful with strong cassis fruit. There is an attractive touch of spice and great complexity. It exudes focus and precision and is one of the finest Saint Julien.

- 54 **CHATEAU D'ISSAN 3EME CRU** BOTTLE £210.00  
MARGAUX, BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
Emmanuel Cruse continues to take this property to new heights. Rigorous selection of only the best grapes led to just 57% of the crop being used in the first wine, which is composed of 69% Cabernet Sauvignon and 31% Merlot. The nose shows excellent intensity with both red and black fruits to the fore; on the palate there is a real density of fruit with impressive length on the finish. Tannins are plentiful but are fine-grained so do not appear austere or aggressive. One of the real finds in the Margaux appellation.

## REDS FROM THE DE SAVARY CELLAR

- 55  CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE  
ROUGE CHANTE CIGALE BOTTLE £88.00  
RHONE, FRANCE  
In recent years as part of the revival of interest in Rhone Valley wines, a group of mostly young growers, all working with consultant oenologist Jean Luc Colombo, has coalesced, called Rhone Vignobles. Yves Cuilleron is one such grower. Since taking over from his uncle, Yves Cuilleron has transformed the estate into one of the appellation's finest. Ruby red in colour with an elegant perfumed fruity nose of raspberry, blueberry, violet and pepper. Fruity, juicy and on the lean side, but firm on the finish.
- 56 AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA FATORRI BOTTLE £99.00  
BASTIA, VERONA, ITALY  
Hand picked grapes during the last two weeks of September and laid to dry in small boxes in "fruttaio". The grapes are allowed to dry gently in well-ventilated rooms for around 4-5 months, concentrating their flavours, sweetness and colour. In winter, the grapes are crushed and the wine matures in wood for 30-36 months before bottling. Produced in tiny quantities this is hedonistic and complex with a nose of cherry liqueur and cinnamon with flavours of green peppercorn, chocolate and dried plum.
- 57 PESQUERA RESERVA RIBERA DEL DUERO BOTTLE £101.00  
RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN  
Burgundy in colour with an intense cherry red rim, clear and bright. This wine has a deep and elegant nose, with intense notes of blackberry and liquorice, and a touch of well-integrated oak. A very elegant wine, its impressive finesse and silkiness reappear after every sip. The finish is long and intense. Well-rounded tannins and a perfectly-integrated acidity give this wine a freshness and liveliness upon drinking and a great potential for long bottle ageing.
- 58  'THE PRESIDENT'S BLEND'  
BODEGA ESCORIHUELA GASCO BOTTLE £110.00

Domaine du Colombier is a family property transmitted over several generations. Currently, three son Guy Mothe, Jean Louis, Thierry and Vincent operate 45 hectares of vineyards. The vineyards are planted exclusively with Chardonnay and produce dry white wines, clear, bright and light, with a characteristic yellow color with subtle white-green hues. Fine mineral aromas with stone fruit notes. On the palate there is a depth of flavour expected of a grand cru, supported by decent acidity and a mineral core. Very long finish.

### 60 MEURSAULT VALLET FRERES

BOTTLE £140.00

BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Meursault lies between the villages of Volnay and Puligny-Montrachet and produces some of the world's greatest white wines. This has a wonderful creaminess on the nose and the palate is well-rounded, poised and elegant with a classic balance between richness and acidity and complex savoury character. Low vine density and extremely strict pruning practices (7 buds to a cane) to maintain low yields are employed at Vallet Frères. Traditional methods are also adopted in the vineyards - in the last 50 years only manure has been used on the mainly limestone soil and harvesting is by hand in order to select the best grapes. One of a handful of producers in the Côte d'Or who continue to use ultra-traditional winemaking techniques. Grapes are selected from vines of a minimum 15 years of age; after pressing the juice is decanted then fermented in open wooden casks using only natural yeasts and no temperature control.

### 61 PULIGNY MONTRACHET PATRICK MIOLANE

BURGUNDY, FRANCE

From south east facing vineyards with vines over 60 years old the grapes are hand harvested and then only the very best grapes are used. Fermentation is naturally started with native yeasts and aged in oak for over 12 months. The wine is then blended with wines from the vat to achieve a harmony between the roundness and complexity of the oak with the freshness and acidity of the vat. Pale yellow in colour, crystal clear and of great purity. There is a distinctive note of hawthorn blossom in the subtle bouquet. On the palate the wine is smooth and mellow, though delicate in texture. It's powerful flavour is mitigated by a fresh acidity, ensuring perfect balance.

### 62 DOMAINE CHANTE CIGALE, CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE BLANC

RHONE, FRANCE

Domaine Chante-Cigale is owned by the Favier-Sabon family - it's been in their hands for generations and is one of the oldest in the region - and occupies some 40 hectares comprised of different parcels of land around the village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, located between Orange and Avignon. Recently Christian Favier the father released the reins to his son, Alexandre, who is fast becoming new rising star of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Despite only being in his early 20's he has been lauded by notable journalists Steve Danzier in the US and Jancis Robinson in the UK. The wine has lots of warm red fruit and damson aromas, with cinnamon, spices and jam but also concentration on the palate; then liquoricey richness and elegance to finish. The wine has been aged for between 14-18 months in 'foudre' (large oak barrels), with 10% in new barrels and 30% in concrete vats.

He pioneered a number of winemaking techniques around 1670—being the first to blend grapes in such a way as to improve the quality of wines, balance one element with another in order to make a better whole, and deal with a number of their imperfections; perfecting the art of producing clear white wines from black grapes by clever manipulation of the presses; Each vintage is a perfectly balanced blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, aged for a minimum of seven years. Exemplary in style, depth and quality, this is simply heavenly
- 64 LOUIS ROEDERER CRISTAL** BOTTLE £350.00  
MARNE CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE  
Our House's most famous wine was created in 1876 to satisfy the demanding tastes of Tsar Alexander II. The emperor asked Louis Roederer to reserve the House's best cuvée for him every year. Cristal is a remarkably balanced and refined champagne whose length is inimitable. It has a silky texture and fruity aromas, complemented by a powerful mineral quality with white fruit and citrus notes.
